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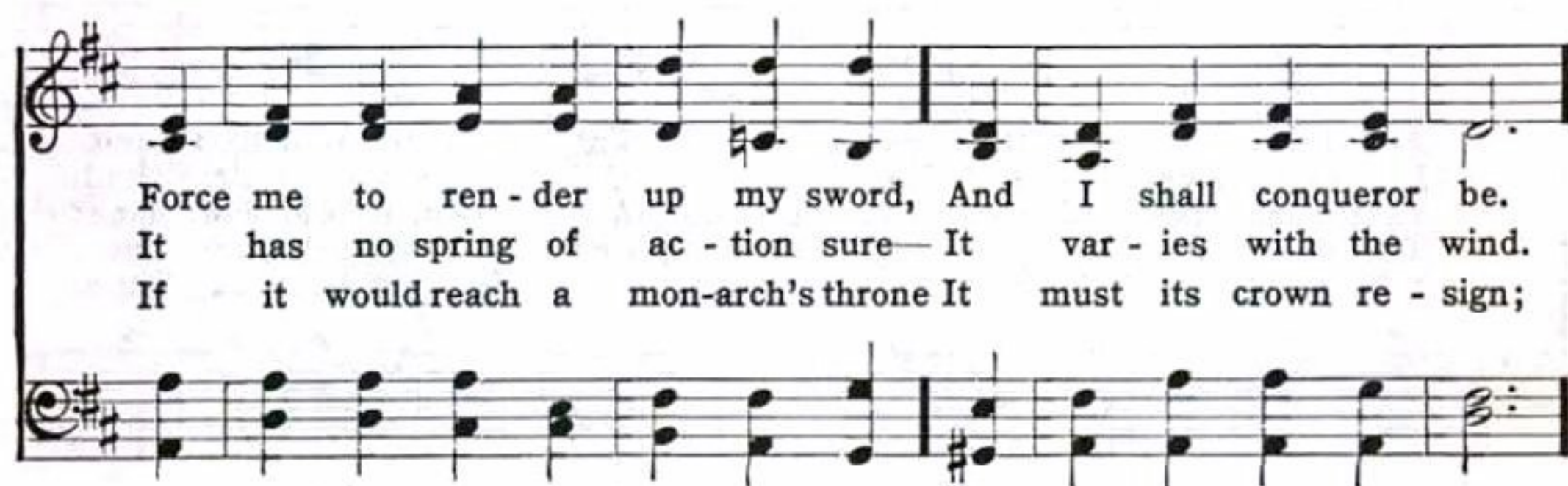

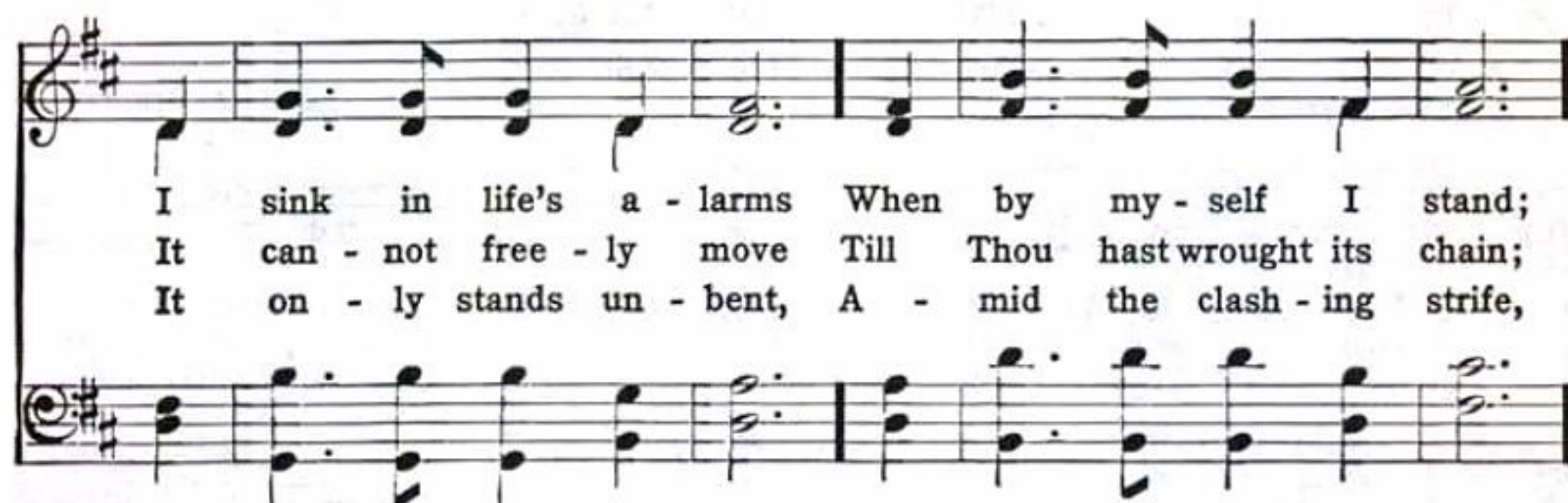

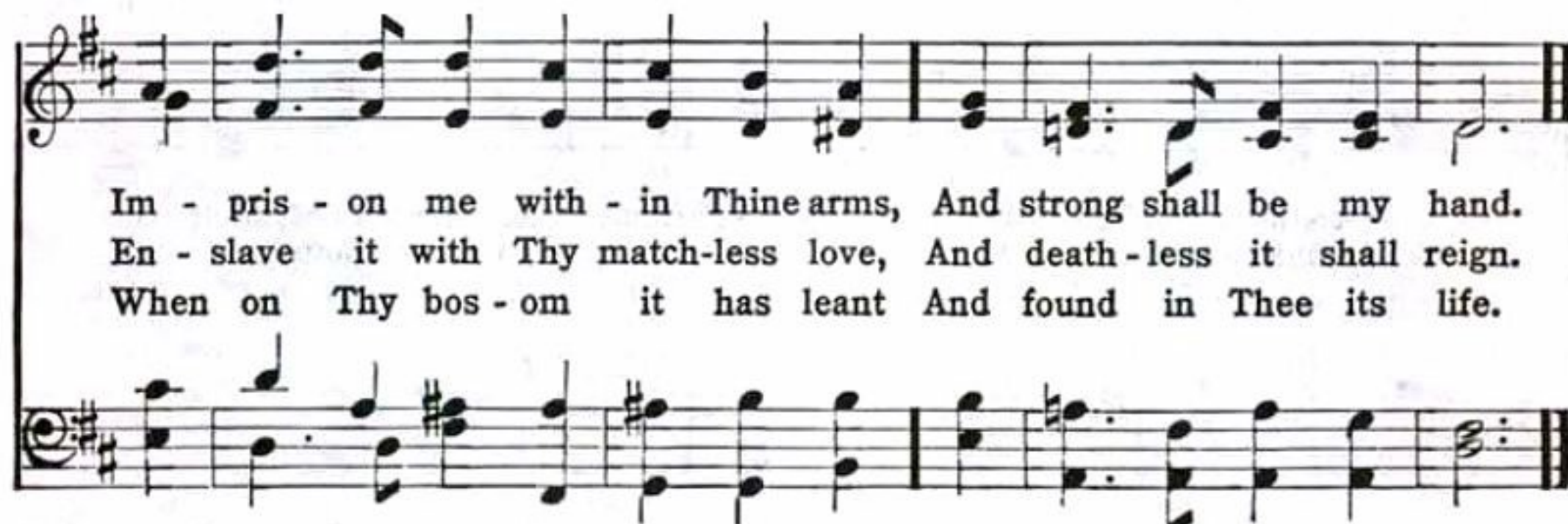

1. Make me a cap - tive, Lord, And then I shall be free;
